

June 8, 2026, 9:00 A.M., the Board of Tillman County Commissioners met in a regularly scheduled meeting with Chairman Joe Don Dickey presiding. Members present were Levi Krasser and Roger Hoover. Minutes of the previous meeting were read by County Clerk Cacy Caldwell. Motion by Krasser to approve the minutes as read. Dickey, Krasser and Hoover voted aye. Sheriff Oscar Juanes discussed the Frederick School lockdown incident that occurred the previous week. Alcohol Beverage/Motor Vehicle Tax Report submitted by Treasurer and monthly reports submitted by Assessor, County Clerk, Court Clerk, Election Board Secretary, Health Department, Sheriff, and Treasurer, including Court Clerk Preservation Fee reports, were approved by general consent. P-Card Payment Approval was approved by general consent. Motion by Krasser to approve Resolution #1878 authorizing and approving the incurring of indebtedness by the Trustees of the Tillman County Industrial Authority to be accomplished by the issuance of lease revenue bonds, bonds, notes or other evidences of indebtedness in one or more series, on a tax-exempt or taxable basis, at a premium or discount, in the aggregate principal par amount of not to exceed Five Million Two Hundred Thousand Dollars and No/100 Dollars (\$5,200,000) to provide funds to complete the acquisition, construction, equipping, renovating, and remodeling of school buildings, acquiring school furniture, fixtures and equipment and acquiring and improving school sites related to Independent School District No. 158 Tillman County, Oklahoma ("Frederick Public Schools" or the "District"); establish a reserve fund, if any, capitalize interest, if any, and pay costs of issuance and all matters related thereto, including but not limited to the waiver of competitive bidding thereof; and declaring an emergency. Dickey, Krasser and Hoover voted aye. Motion by Hoover to approve conveyance of property sold through Commissioner's Sale to Kendra Rodriguez, for \$203.32 property as follows: Lots Four (4) and Five (5), in Block A, Willis Addition to the town of Davidson.
