Members present were Joe Don Dickey and Roger Hoover. Minutes of the previous meeting were read by County Clerk Cacy Caldwell. Motion by Dickey to approve the minutes as read. Krasser, Dickey and Hoover voted aye. Emergency Management/Safety Director Mike Thornton informed the Board that he completed two FEMA classes last week and will attend a table top exercise at Comanche County this week. Sheriff Oscar Juanes informed the Board that he and Undersheriff Ebner attended the Sheriff's Association Conference and completed continuing education. Monthly reports submitted by Election Board Secretary and Court Clerk were approved by general consent. Motion by Hoover to approve overage on Blanket PO #671 in the amount of \$100.00 and #664 in the amount of \$400.63, Highway Fund, Dist. 1. Krasser, Dickey and Hoover voted aye. 




