RESOLUTION # 1340

WHEREAS, per 47 O.S. § 11-801(F) the speed limit of all county roads is fifty-five miles per hour unless otherwise posed by the Board of County Commissioners; and,

WHEREAS, County Road East West 173, also known as Baseline Road, is currently under construction; and,


WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, in an effort to ensure the safety of those who are travelling the road and those who are completing the construction work, has determined that it is necessary to temporarily decrease the speed limit between Manitou city limit and County Road North South 229; and,

WHEREAS, the terms of this Resolution shall commence immediately and end upon completion of the road construction project and when the roadway is deemed safe for a higher speed limit.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tillman County Board of County Commissioners hereby reduces the speed limit on County Road 173 (Baseline Road) from fifty-five (55) miles per hour to thirty-five (35) miles per hour in the area from Manitou city limit to County Road North South 229 for the duration of the Baseline Road (CREW 173) construction project and until the roadway is deemed safe for a higher speeds.
