RESOLUTION # 1500

WHEREAS, on the 27<sup>th</sup> of August, 2002, the voters of Tillman County voted to levy a sales a one-cent sales tax for the purposes as follows: 5% Fair, 12% Extension Office, 20% Capital Improvement, and 63% County Government; and,

WHEREAS, in preparing the 2020-2021 fiscal year general fund budget, the Tillman County Board of County Commissioners and the Tillman County Excise Board have reviewed the Estimates of Needs submitted and have determined that it is in the best interest of Tillman County to use the said sales tax proceeds allocated to County Government for General Fund employee benefits for the 2020-2021 fiscal year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tillman County Board of County Commissioners and the Tillman County Excise Board hereby direct the 63% of 1 cent sales tax, also known as the County Government sales tax, to be appropriated to the Personnel Services Account of the Sales Tax Revolving Fund and to be used for General Fund employee benefits to include the County's portion of employees' insurance premiums, retirement contributions, and unemployment contributions.
