

RESOLUTION # 1567

**APPROVING COUNTY COMMISSIONER DISTRICT BOUNDARIES**

**WHEREAS**, O.S.19 § 321 requires a county to be divided into three districts by the Board of County Commissioners as equal in population as practical; and

**WHEREAS**, O.S.19 § 321 requires for the purposes of the 2021 reapportionment, Board to reapportion on or before November 30, 2021, following the official publication of the Federal Decennial Census; and

**WHEREAS**, all boundaries of county commissioner districts shall follow clearly visible, definable and observable physical boundaries; and


**WHEREAS**, the Voting Rights Act and subsequent court opinions have held that County Commissioner Districts' populations may be within 5% of each other to be in compliance; and

**WHEREAS**, the County Commissioner Districts shall have the following populations: District 1, 2,214; District 2, 2,340; and, District 3, 2,414, and meet the criteria listed above.


**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT**, the Board of County Commissioners of Tillman County hereby approves the County Commissioner district boundaries.


