RESOLUTION # 1573

BE IT REMEMBERED that on the 15th day of November, 2021 at a regular meeting of the Board of County Commissioners of Tillman County, the following resolution was presented, read and adopted:

WHEREAS, Essential worker means workers needed to maintain continuity of operations of essential critical infrastructure sectors, including: any work performed by an employee of a State, local, or Tribal government; and


WHEREAS, essential work means work that is not performed while teleworking from a residence and involves regular in person interactions with the public or coworkers of the individual that is performing the work; or regular physical handling of items that were handled by, or are to be handled by patients, the public, or coworkers of the individual that is performing the work; and

WHEREAS, essential worker does not include elected officials or officers whose salaries are set by state statute;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners of Tillman County hereby recognizes the employees of the Commissioner District 1, Commissioner District 2, Commissioner District 3, County Assessor, County Treasurer, County Clerk, Court Clerk, Sheriff, Dispatch and the Jail departments within Tillman County as essential to the continuity of county government business and thereby are eligible for premium pay according to the interim final rule promulgated by the U. S. Treasury in accordance with the American Rescue Plan Act.
