RESOLUTION # 1695

BE IT REMEMBERED that on the 7th day of August, 2023 at a regular meeting of the Board of County Commissioners of Tillman County, the following resolution was presented, read and adopted:

WHEREAS, 19 O.S. § 180.71-180.83 concerns the calculation of the annual salary of county officers where personal property and livestock are exempt from ad valorem taxation; and

WHEREAS, Tillman County exempts personal property and livestock from ad valorem taxation; and

WHEREAS, service-ability, population, and the mill-levy rate of the county are used to calculate the base salary of county officers; and

WHEREAS, the FY2024 mill-levy is 10.46, the population 6,968, and the service-ability is \$58,200,657.00 for Tillman County; and

WHEREAS, using the information above, the minimum base salary is \$19,000.00 and the maximum base salary is \$44,500.00; and,

WHEREAS, the statutes allow for an increase to the base salary based on serviceability; and,

WHEREAS, the allowable increase for Tillman County based on serviceability is \$5,800.00, and

WHEREAS, the statutes require an increase to the base salary based on population; and,


WHEREAS, the required increase for Tillman County based on population is \$87.50; and,

WHEREAS, the minimum total salary allowed by law for Tillman County officers is \$24,887.50 and the maximum is \$55,387.50.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners of Tillman County hereby sets the annual salary for elected officials for FY2024 at \$42,840.00

ADOPTED by the Board of Tillman County Commissioners this 7th day of August, 2023.


