BE IT REMEMBERED that on the 29th day of April, 2024, at a regular meeting of the Board of County Commissioners of Tillman County, the following resolution was presented, read and adopted:


WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners recognizes the need for municipalities within Tillman County to seek financially advantageous business arrangements; and,

WHEREAS, the Board wishes to ensure that local law enforcement is not overwhelmed due to new business arrangements and that any plans for such arrangements will take into consideration the welfare of all entities and citizens of the County.


NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED that the Tillman County Board of County Commissioners does hereby proclaim that any county government wishing to establish a correctional institution or other detention operation within Tillman County may not do so without the express written consent of the Tillman County Board of County Commissioners in order to ensure that the Tillman County Board of County Commissioners will have input and oversight, particularly with regard to the potential additional burden on local law enforcement, including the Tillman County Sheriff's Department, and to ensure the welfare of the citizens of the County.
