BE IT REMEMBERED that on the 3rd day of September, 2024, at a regular meeting of the Board of County Commissioners of Tillman County, the following resolution was presented, read and adopted:

WHEREAS, a vacancy will be created in the office of Tillman County Sheriff due to the tragic loss of Sheriff William "Bill" Ingram on June 15, 2024; and,

WHEREAS, the term of office began on January 1, 2020 and continues until December 31, 2024; and,

WHEREAS, 51 O.S. § 10 directs the Board of County Commissioners to make appointments filling county office vacancies and to call special elections to fill vacancies, providing the balance of the term does not expire in the year following the next succeeding general election; and,

WHEREAS, at a general election held June 18, 2024, Oscar Juanes was elected to serve as County Sheriff beginning on January 1, 2025.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that,

Section 1. Oscar Juanes is appointed to fill the vacancy in the office of Tillman County Sheriff, created by the death of William "Bill" Ingram, and at the same salary designated for the office of Tillman County Sheriff.

Section 2. The appointment shall be effective September 9, 2024, upon administration of the oath of office, and said appointment shall continue until the end of the regular term of William "Bill" Ingram and his term begins.
