A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY TO REAPPLY FOR OPIOID ABATEMENT FUNDING THROUGH THE OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL

BE IT REMEMBERED that on the 14th day of October, 2024, at a regular meeting of the Board of County Commissioners of Tillman County, the following resolution was presented, read and adopted:

WHEREAS, the County of Tillman recognizes the significant impact the opioid crisis has had on the community, leading to an increase in opioid misuse, addiction, and related public health and safety challenges; and,

WHEREAS, the Attorney General's Office has made opioid abatement funding available to assist communities in addressing and mitigating the effects of the opioid crisis; and,

WHEREAS, the County of Tillman seeks to enhance its efforts in combating opioid misuse and supporting individuals and families affected by the crisis; and,

WHEREAS, the District Attorney, in collaboration with local agencies, is in a strategic position to lead initiatives aimed at opioid abatement within the community;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County of Tillman, as follows:

- 1. The District Attorney in conjunction with Oklahoma Alliance for Recovery Resources is hereby authorized and directed to prepare and submit an application for opioid abatement funding through the Office of the Attorney General.
- 2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
